Inspector Observations: Observed 8 live cockroaches throughout prep area. Behind the two compartment sink. On the walls by the handwashing sink and mechanical warewash. On the wall by the dough mixer and on the shelves in the storage area. Also observed many dead cockroaches in the storage area. [CA] The premises of each food facility shall be kept free of vermin. A food facility shall not operate when there is a vermin infestation that has resulted in the contamination of food contact surfaces, food packaging, utensils, food equipment, or adulteration of food(s). The food facility shall cease operation of the food facility immediately. The food facility shall remain closed until: there is no longer evidence of a vermin infestation; all contaminated surfaces have been cleaned and sanitized; and contributing factors such as cleaning, repairs, and the elimination of harborages have been resolved.

Overall Comments:

This is a follow up inspection to the routine inspection conducted on 7/9/2019. Facility has corrected all minor violations observed in routine inspection report. Facility has been thoroughly cleaned and sanitized.

Facility has had pest control services and pest control technician was onsite during follow up inspection where 8 live cockroaches were found as well as dead cockroaches.

Facility will remain closed at this time and will not reopen until a second charged follow up inspection is conducted. Ensure that all evidence of cockroaches is eliminated and that no live cockroaches are found at follow up inspection.

Facility is to cease and desist all food sales and operations, including food preparation. Do not remove, cover-up, or relocated red placard. Failure to comply may result in enforcement actions.

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CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **7/24/2019**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.
