K08 - 8 Points - Improperly using time as a public health control procedures & records; 114000

Inspector Observations: Pastries that require time marking in front display are not time market for TPHC as stated in written procedures posted next to display.

[CA] When time only, rather than time and temperature is used as a public health control, PHFs shall be time marked to indicate when item is removed from temperature control, discarded if not consumed or served within 4 hours, and written procedures shall be readily available for review. [COS] PIC time marked pastries, ultimately, due to closure, pastries were placed back into walk in fridge after being out for one hour.

K23 - 8 Points - Observed rodents, insects, birds, or animals; 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5

Inspector Observations: 1. Observed Vermin: Documented in the following areas: Observed rodent droppings behind non working reach in fridge, on top of the water heater, along the wall and under the dry storage shelves, along the wall and under the three compartment sink and on the drain board of the three compartment sink.

4. Notification: The person in charge during inspection, Sean, has been informed that the facility must close immediately.

[CA]: The premises of each food facility must be maintained free of vermin. A facility cannot operate if there is a vermin infestation that leads to contamination of food contact surfaces, packaging, utensils, food equipment, or adulteration of food. The facility is required to cease operations immediately and must remain closed until all corrective actions on the provided checklist are completed.

1. Email the signed and completed Reopening Checklist to the assigned inspector.

2. Submit a copy of the pest control report from a licensed provider.

Inspector Observations: While writing the report for a neighboring facility, observed a customer come to the side door of the facility. Employee came out and handed a package of bread to the customer. Inspector asked the customer how they ordered their food, the customer stated that they ordered the food online. Facility's health permit has been suspended due to vermin infestation. Notice of violation will be issued to facility. [CA] A food facility shall not be open for business without a valid health permit.

CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **9/2/2025**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.
