Overall Comments:

This is the first follow up inspection after the facility was closed for an active cockroach infestation. A completed and signed checklist for reopening along with a pest control report was provided prior to this inspection.

This is the second vermin closure this calendar year. Permit holder to be subject to an office conference with this department if facility's permit is suspended once more due to vermin activity.

Observations: Facility has sealed the underside of the counter tops inside and outside of the facility space. Seams along metal corner guards were also sealed. A crack between the quarry tile cove base tiles in the corner of the cookline was also sealed. No evidence of vermin was observed. Discussed with operator to provide supplemental pest control services in addition to the single monthly visit conducted by Terminix provided by the market.

Facility is okay to reopen.

FACILITY RE-OPENED / PERMIT REINSTATED

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **9/3/2026**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.
