**Inspector Observations: Dead oriental and german cockroaches observed on sticky monitoring traps:**

- Behind white refrigerator and water dispenser.
- Underneath three-compartment sink.

No live activity was observed.

Rodent droppings observed on floor behind food preparation table directly right when entering the kitchen.

No live activity was observed.

**[CA] Clean and sanitize area of dead cockroaches or old droppings. The premises of each food facility shall be kept free of vermin. A food facility shall not operate when there is a vermin infestation that has resulted in the contamination of food contact surfaces, food packaging, utensils, food equipment, or adulteration of food(s). The food facility shall cease operation of the food facility immediately. The food facility shall remain closed until: there is no longer evidence of a vermin infestation; all contaminated surfaces have been cleaned and sanitized; and contributing factors such as cleaning, repairs, and the elimination of harborages have been resolved.**

- On-site for follow-up inspection to verify compliance of K23m.
- K23m - No rodents, insects, birds, or animals:
  - Facility is still in the process of deep cleaning.
  - Monitoring traps have been replaced since routine inspection with activity still observed. See violation above.
  - Continue to deep clean facility - remove standing water, grease, grime, food residue, and/or food debris.
  - Maintain rear door closed at all times.
  - Seal all holes, gaps, cracks, and/or crevices on ceilings and walls.
  - Provide pest control reports upon follow-up and inspections.
- Continue to clean and maintain facility free of vermin.
- Continue to address all other violations noted on routine inspection report.

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **4/26/2023**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.
