Major Violations

No major violations were observed during this inspection.

Minor Violations

K01 - 3 Points - Inadequate demonstration of knowledge; food manager certification

Inspector Observations: Lacking food safety certificate (FSC) on site. [CA] Food facilities that prepare, handle, or serve non-prepackaged potentially hazard foods shall have a valid Food Safety Certificate available for review at all times.

K36 - 2 Points - Equipment, utensils, linens: Improper storage and use; 114074, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185.2, 114185.3, 114185.4, 114185.5

Inspector Observations: Observed the following food items without lids or sneeze guard in self service area: yogurt, apples and cut fruits. [CA] Facility shall provide sneeze guards and/or lids for food items in self-service area to prevent accidental contamination.

K41 - 2 Points - Plumbing unapproved, not installed, not in good repair; improper backflow devices; 114171, 114189.1, 114190, 114192, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269

Inspector Observations: Found leaking faucets at the following area: 3 comp sink (middle section) when water is on and hand wash faucet when water is off. [CA] Secure leak.

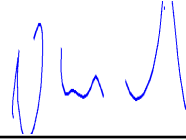
