**Inspector Observations: 1. Observed Vermin: Documented in the following areas:**

- 2 live adult cockroaches underneath the 1-door preparation unit in food preparation area (abated during inspection).

- 1 live adult cockroach underneath the preparation sink in the back area (abated during inspection).

- 5+ live nymphs underneath the 1-door preparation unit and storage shelves in food preparation area (abated during inspection).

- 1 dead adult cockroach underneath the counter adjacent to 1-door preparation unit

- 1 dead adult cockroach underneath the preparation sink in the back area

3. Supervisor Notified: Anjani Sircari

4. Notification: The person in charge during inspection, Sunisa Laphong, has been informed that the facility must close immediately.

**[CA]: The premises of each food facility must be maintained free of vermin. A facility cannot operate if there is a vermin infestation that leads to contamination of food contact surfaces, packaging, utensils, food equipment, or adulteration of food. The facility is required to cease operations immediately and must remain closed until all corrective actions on the provided checklist are completed.**

**Inspector Observations: Observed gaps in the facility:**

- Holes in the ceiling above the dining area

- Hole in the wall underneath the 3-compartment sink

**[CA] Seal all gaps in the facility. The facility shall be fully enclosed to prevent pest entrance and harborage. Gaps shall be sealed prior to reopening.**

#### Overall Comments:

On-site to conduct a follow-up to the routine inspection closure from 8/12/2025 per facility request.

The facility will remain closed due to evidence of vermin infestation (K23). The facility is required to cease operations immediately and must remain closed until all corrective actions on the provided checklist are completed.

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**- The second follow-up inspection will be charged. The follow-up inspection fee must be paid prior to the re-inspection. Subsequent follow-up inspections shall be billed at \$298/hour during normal business hours (Monday - Friday, 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM), and \$645/hour during non-business hours, and upon inspector availability.**

**- The posted placard is property of the Santa Clara County Department of Environmental Health and shall not be removed, covered-up, relocated, tampered, or copied. Failure to comply may result in enforcement actions per County Ordinance Code Section B11-55.**

**- A facility found to be in continued operation without a permit may incur a penalty of three (3) times the operating permit fee, and fee(s) for re-inspection(s) charged at the current hourly rate approved by the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors. Penalties and fees incurred due to enforcement activities must be paid in full prior to the issuance of an operating permit.**

## CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **8/28/2025**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing. After these violations have been corrected, you must call the Department of Environmental Health for a reinspection to reinstate the permit to operate. Phone #: (408)918-3400.
