Inspector Observations: 1. Observed Vermin: Documented in the following areas: Observed on live adult cockroach in the electrical panel in between the knife rack and the preparation sink. Observed two dead cockroaches in the gas rice maker under the hood and one dead cockroach under the warming insert across from the rice maker.

2. Photographs: Taken for documentation purposes.

3. Supervisor Notified: S. Lew

4. Notification: The person in charge during inspection, Daniel, has been informed that the facility must remain closed.

This is a charged follow up visit requested by manager.

Continue to eliminate harborage areas for the cockroaches and continue to clean areas in facility noted by inspectors and any others identified, consult pest control regarding next steps, clean up evidence of cockroaches.

Contact district specialist Jennifer Rios at (408) 918-3480 to schedule re inspection once the above requirements are completed.

- Subsequent follow-up inspection after first follow-up shall be billed \$298/hour, minimum one hour, during normal business hours (Monday - Friday, 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM), and \$645, minimum two hours, during non-business hours, and upon inspector availability.

- The posted placard is property of the Santa Clara County Department of Environmental Health and shall not be removed, covered-up, relocated, tampered, or copied. Failure to comply may result in enforcement actions per County Ordinance Code Section B11-55.

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- A facility found to be in continued operation without a permit may incur a penalty of three (3) times the operating permit fee, and fee(s) for re-inspection(s) charged at the current hourly rate approved by the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors. Penalties and fees incurred due to enforcement activities must be paid in full prior to the issuance of an operating permit

CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **10/21/2025**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing. After these violations have been corrected, you must call the Department of Environmental Health for a reinspection to reinstate the permit to operate. Phone #: (408)918-3400.
