Comments and Observations

Major Violations

No major violations were observed during this inspection.

Minor Violations

K06 - 3 Points - Inadequate handwash facilities: supplied or accessible; 113953, 113953.1, 113953.2, 114067(f)

Inspector Observations: Hand wash sink near front prep sink is not operating.

[CA] All food facilities shall provide an operable handwashing station.

[SA] Another hand wash sink is available nearby on other side of cookline.

Repair this handwash sink no later than 3/13/26 and email a video proof to district specialist at sukhreet.kaur@deh.sccgov.org

K09 - 3 Points - Improper cooling methods; 114002, 114002.1

Inspector Observations: Measred soup at 114 cooling in a metal pot on bottom shelf of prep table. Per PIC, soup was cooked about an hour ago.

[CA] After heating or hot holding, Potentially Hazardous Foods (PHFs) shall be cooled rapidly from 135°F to 70°F within 2 hours and from 70°F to 41°F within 4 hours. Approved cooling methods include:

- 1) Placing the food in shallow pans
- 2) Separating the food into thinner or smaller portions.
- 3) Using rapid cooling equipment (Ex. blast chiller)
- 4) Using containers that facilitate heat transfer (ex. stainless steel)
- 5) Adding ice as an ingredient.
- 6) Using ice paddles
- 7) Using an ice bath and stirring frequently
- 8) Accordance with a HACCP plan. Cooling foods shall have enough space around the containers for cold air to circulate, be loosely covered, or uncovered and stirred as frequently needed to evenly cool.

K26 - 2 Points - Unapproved thawing methods used; frozen food; 114018, 114020, 114020.1

Inspector Observations: Observed meat being thawed in standing water in perp sink.

[CA] Frozen potentially hazardous food shall only be thawed in one of the following ways:

- 1) under refrigeration that maintains the food temperature at 41°F or below,
- 2) completely submerged under potable running water for a period not to exceed two hours at a water temperature of 70°F or below, and with sufficient water velocity to agitate and flush off loose particles into the sink drain,
- 3) in a microwave oven if immediately followed by immediate preparation,
- 4) as part of a cooking process.

K27 - 2 Points - Food not separated and unprotected; 113984(a-d,f), 113986, 114060, 114067(a,d,e,j), 114069(a,b), 114077, 114089.1(c), 114143(c)

Inspector Observations: Observed food containers stored on floor throughout the kitchen.

[CA] Food shall be stored at least 6 inches above the floor to prevent contamination.

K33 - 2 Points - Nonfood contact surfaces not clean; 114115(c)

Inspector Observations: Observed fan guard accumulated with dust and dirt.

[CA] Clean the fan guards and maintain in good condition.

K40 - 2 Points - Wiping cloths: improperly used and stored; 114135, 114185.1 114185.3(d,e)

Inspector Observations: Observed wiping cloth on prep table without sanitizer.

[CA] Wiping towels shall be stored in sanitizing solution of an approved concentration when not in use (100 ppm - chlorine, 200 ppm - quaternary ammonium).

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K41 - 2 Points - Plumbing unapproved, not installed, not in good repair; improper backflow devices; 114171, 114189.1, 114190, 114192, 114193, 114193.1, 114199, 114201, 114269

Inspector Observations: Hand wash sink near mop sink is leaking drops of water.
[CA] Repair plumbing fixture and maintain in clean and good repair.

K44 - 2 Points - Premises not clean, not in good repair; No personal/chemical storage; inadequate vermin-proofing; 114067(j), 114123, 114143 (a,b), 114256, 114256.1, 114256.2, 114256.4, 114257, 114257.1, 114259, 114259.2, 114259.3, 114279, 114281, 114282

Inspector Observations: Observed multiple cardboards stored inside the mop sink.
[CA] The premises of a food facility shall be free of litter and items that are unnecessary to the operation or maintenance of the facility, such as equipment that is nonfunctional or no longer used.
