Follow up inspection conducted regarding limited inspection on 08/14/26 for rodent activity.

During follow up inspection, Specialist observed:

-floors under the kick panels were cleaned.

-store director provided photos when shelves were removed and cleaned.

-no evidence of vermin observed.

-pest control reports from Western Exterminator Company for services on 08/14/26 and 08/15/26 provided. Both reports confirmed no vermin activities/evidence.

-store director stated that the facility will increase routine cleaning of the sales floor perimeter and underneath the kick panels of aisles to prevent accumulation of debris and dirt.

-Continue to follow pest control service recommendations and monitor for vermin activity. Seal all cracks, crevices, and gaps under any exterior doors to prevent entry and harborage of vermin

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **9/1/2026**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.
