Inspector Observations: One nymph cockroach was observed crawling on the preparation table next to the preparation sink, and seven adults were observed on the stepper used to grab food items from the storage shelves, and one nymph was observed crawling on the wall near the reach-in freezer and the storage shelf in the dry storage area. [CA] A FOOD FACILITY shall always be constructed, equipped, maintained, and operated as to prevent the entrance and harborage of animals, birds, and VERMIN, including, but not limited to, rodents and insects. Clean and sanitize all food contact surfaces, and cooking areas. Must also clean walls, and if it is possible move equipment to reach overhead or enclosed areas. Obtain service of a professional pest control company today (03/12/2021), and use effective measures to control the entrance and harborage of cockroaches in the food facility.

Food facility is closed due to vermin infestation, and such facility shall remain closed until violation is corrected, and upon approval by the enforcement officer. Immediately cease and desist food operation until vermin infestation (cockroaches) is controlled.
