Due to association with grocery store, FA0206367 and PR0300546, food program has been suspended due to evidence of vermin. Deli program cannot be adequately isolated from grocery area.

Facility is prohibited from all food service activities which include, but not limited to: preparation, service, handling, distribution, and sale.

Facility shall remain closed until vermin infestation is completely abated and authorization is provided by this Division.

Requirements Before Reopening:

- 1. Email the signed and completed Reopening Checklist to the assigned inspector.*
- 2. Submit a copy of the pest control report from a licensed provider.*

Once the above is corrected, submit the completed item to: helen.dinh@deh.sccgov.org and/or anjani.sircar@deh.sccgov.org and/or contact the main office at 408/918-3400 to schedule the follow-up inspection.

***Subsequent follow-up inspection after first follow-up shall be billed \$282/hour one hour minimum, during normal business hours (Monday - Friday, 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM), or \$645 for a minimum of two hours, during non business hours and in accordance with the inspector's availability.*

***The posted placard is property of the Santa Clara County Department of Environmental Health and shall not be removed, covered-up, relocated, tampered, or copied. Failure to comply may result in enforcement actions per County Ordinance Code Section B11-55.*

A facility found to be in continued operation without a permit may incur a penalty of three (3) times the operating permit fee, and fee(s) for re-inspection(s) charged at the current hourly rate approved by the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors.

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CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **9/28/2026**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing. After these violations have been corrected, you must call the Department of Environmental Health for a reinspection to reinstate the permit to operate. Phone #: (408)918-3400.
