A reinspection was conducted on this date as requested by manager Jeffrey, to verify the abatement of the major violations as observed during the 7/28/26 inspection.

On this date cockroach activity was still observed at the following locations and shall remain closed:

- 1 live (dying) nymph on the floor below the two door reach in cooler at the sushi bar
- 1 live adult german cockroach on the middle cooler between the units, to the right of the warewashing sink
- 1 live adult german cockroach in the crevice between the wall mounted shelf and wall above the warewashing sink
- 1 live adult german cockroach on the paper ANSUL release tag near the cooks line
- 2 live adult german cockroaches on the floor near the back dry storage/preparation area below the shelving and hand washing sink

Facility is prohibited from all food service activities which include, but not limited to: preparation, service, handling, distribution, and sale.

- The posted placard is property of the Santa Clara County Department of Environmental Health and shall not be removed, covered-up, relocated, tampered, or copied red placard. Failure to comply may result in enforcement actions per County Ordinance Code Section B11-55.

- A facility found to be in continued operation without a permit may incur a penalty of three (3) times the operating permit fee, and fee(s) for re-inspection(s) charged at the current hourly rate approved by the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors. Penalties and fees incurred due to enforcement activities must be paid in full prior to the issuance of an operating permit.

CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

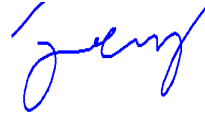
When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **8/14/2026**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.
