## Comments and Observations

### Major Violations

K14 - 8 Points - Food contact surfaces unclean and unsanitized; 113984(e), 114097, 114099.1, 114099.4, 114099.6, 114101, 114105, 114109, 114111, 114113, 114115(a,b,d), 114117, 14125(b), 114141

**Inspector Observations: Conveyor dishwasher measured to have rinse cycle at 141F.**

**[CA] Mechanical sanitization shall be accomplished in the final sanitizing rinse by achieving a utensil surface temperature of 160°F (or manufacturer's instruction). [SA] All dishes washed from today were taken to back 3-comp area to be manually sanitized in 200ppm quat ammonia. Facility shall manually sanitize until dishwasher can maintain 160F rinse cycle.**

### Minor Violations

K07 - 3 Points - Improper hot and cold holding temperatures; 11387.1, 113996, 113998, 114037, 114343(a)

**Inspector Observations: Milk in sandwich prep cooler measured to be 47F. [CA] Maintain temperature at 41F and below for cold holding PHFs. [COS] Milk moved to walk in cooler.**

K09 - 3 Points - Improper cooling methods; 114002, 114002.1

**Inspector Observations: Cooked pork measured to be 94F by side of station on counter. Per employee finished about 1 hr 20 minutes prior. [CA]**

**[CA] After heating or hot holding, Potentially Hazardous Foods (PHFs) shall be cooled rapidly from 135°F to 70°F within 2 hours and from 70°F to 41°F within 4 hours. Approved cooling methods include: 1) Placing the food in shallow pans 2) Separating the food into thinner or smaller portions. 3) Using rapid cooling equipment (Ex. blast chiller) 4) Using containers that facilitate heat transfer (ex. stainless steel) 5) Adding ice as an ingredient. 6) Using ice paddles 7) Using an ice bath and stirring frequently 8) Accordance with a HACCP plan. Cooling foods shall have enough space around the containers for cold air to circulate, be loosely covered, or uncovered and stirred as frequently needed to evenly cool.**

**[COS] Pork was moved to cooling rack in walk in cooler to cool.**

K30 - 2 Points - Food storage containers are not identified; 114047, 114049, 114051, 114053, 114055, 114067(h), 114069 (b)

**Inspector Observations: Open bags of dry bulk flour observed to be kept on shelves at dry storage room [CA] Keep open foods stored in containers with tight fitting lids to prevent cross contamination.**

K32 - 2 Points - Food improperly labeled & not honestly presented: 114087, 114089, 114089.1(a, b), 114090, 114093.1

**Inspector Observations: Prepackaged cookies, snails, and other baked goods at checkout counter observed to be missing labels.**

**[CA] Food repackaged in a food facility shall bear a label with the following: 1) common name of the food, 2) list of ingredients in descending order of predominance by weight, 3) quantity of contents, 4) name and place of business of the manufacturer, packer, or distributor.**

### Overall Comments:

**NOTE: Unpermitted vendor observed outside of facility. Per operator, Food Fleet was contacted to organize event outside.**

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When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge.
