A reinspection was conducted on this date as requested by Frank Tsai, the owner to verify the abatement of cockroach activity initially observed during the 7/28/26 complaint investigation and 7/31/26 reinspection.

On this date:

- The completed and signed re-opening inspection checklist has been received*
- Pest control reports dated for 7/31/26, 8/1/26, 8/2/26, 8/4/26, and 8/5/26 from Polaris Pest Elimination have been received which also indicate no further evidence of cockroach activity*
- No further evidence of cockroach activity was observed at this*

Continue monitoring for additional cockroach activity and identifying additional cracks, crevices, and gaps that may provide the harborage of vermin.

This is the second re-inspection and will be charged. The health permit is hereby reinstated and facility okay to operate

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **8/20/2026**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.
