Inspector Observations: 1. Observed Vermin: Documented in the following areas: Rodent droppings still observed on wooden beam running through facility along sides. Rodent droppings also observed on top of boxes near cooking and food equipment.

One dead cockroach observed on the floor under shelves.

[CA]: The premises of each food facility must be maintained free of vermin. A facility cannot operate if there is a vermin infestation that leads to contamination of food contact surfaces, packaging, utensils, food equipment, or adulteration of food. Facility operates as auxiliary storage for Panda Express building near by. Facility shall not use any food contact equipment or food stored inside this storage area. The facility is required to cease operations immediately and must remain closed until all corrective actions on the provided checklist are completed. Panda Express may operate and store foods and food contact equipment in main store or other permitted food facility near by in Great America temporary.

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CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

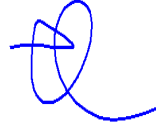
When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than 7/22/2026. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.
