At time of follow-up inspection, the following was observed:

- Two dead cockroaches near the handwash sink located behind the front counter.
- One dead cockroach observed under the three compartment sink.
- Two live cockroaches on glue traps from the kitchen

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- One live cockroach on glue trap located under soda dispenser
- One live nymph cockroach on the walk-in cooler.
- Reviewed most recent pest control service report from the date 9/27/24. Service report showed treatment was conducted.

Facility shall remain closed until there are no further evidence of cockroach infestation.

- Continue to clean and sanitize areas of dead cockroaches.
- Fill any holes, gaps, and/or crevices that may harbor vermin.
- Additional pest control treatment is recommended and provide service report upon next follow-up inspection.

Subsequent follow-up inspection will be billed \$298/hour, minimum one hour, during normal business hours (Mon - Fri 7:30am - 4:30pm), and \$645/hour, minimum two hours, during non business hours and subject to availability of an inspector.

Penalties and fees incurred due to enforcement activities must be paid in full prior to the issuance of an operating permit.**

CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **10/23/2024**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.
