Follow-up inspection for facility due to cockroach infestation.

At time of inspection, no live or dead cockroaches were observed. All areas has been cleaned and sanitized. Gaps and crevices around area where cockroach activity were previously noted has been sealed.

Reviewed most recent pest control report dated 7/17/24 which notes there was no live cockroaches and only "dead activity" were observed with no additional details.

Facility is okay to re-open.

This is a subsequent follow-up inspection and will be billed \$298/hour.

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **7/31/2024**.
