Overall Comments:

This was a follow-up to the 11/27/24 routine inspection. Measured temperature of yogurt in upright refrigerator to be 41F.

Only one major violation was observed at the follow-up (lack of paper towels at restroom handwash sink); the placard was changed from yellow to green.

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made.
