Major Violations

K23 - 8 Points - Observed rodents, insects, birds, or animals; 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5

Inspector Observations:

Live mouse observed on a glue trap on the left side of the 2 door prep cooler. A dead mouse was observed under the prep sink. Mouse droppings observed in the following areas: on the floor under the metal wire rack by the 3 door upright cooler, on the floors on the elevated platform behind the big screen TV, on the floor around the buffet station, on the floor between the chairs in the dining room, on the floor behind the 2 door prep cooler, on the floor under the prep sink, on the platform of the pass through window.

[Correct Action] The premises of each food facility shall be kept free of vermin. A food facility shall not operate when there is a vermin infestation that has resulted in the contamination of food contact surfaces, food packaging, utensils, food equipment, or adulteration of food(s). The food facility shall cease operation of the food facility immediately. The food facility shall remain closed until: there is no longer evidence of a vermin infestation; all contaminated surfaces have been cleaned and sanitized; and contributing factors such as cleaning, repairs, and the elimination of harborages have been resolved.

Minor Violations

K45 - 2 Points - Floor, walls, ceilings: not built, not maintained, not clean; 114143(d), 114266, 114268, 114268.1, 114271, 114272

Inspector Observations: Observed a hole in the elevated floor behind the big screen TV. The hole was observed patched during the last follow-up inspection. [Corrective Action] Patch the hole with a stronger material.
