#### Major Violations

K23 - 8 Points - Observed rodents, insects, birds, or animals; 114259.1, 114259.4, 114259.5

**Inspector Observations: Numerous (over ten) live cockroaches (of all life stages) found throughout facility (on walls, floors, shelving). Numerous (over ten) dead cockroaches found throughout facility (on floors, in equipment, in handwash sink). Pest control report states that presence of cockroaches was found and was unable to perform full service due to facility not cleaning or preparing for service. [CA] The premises of each food facility shall be kept free of vermin. A food facility shall not operate when there is a vermin infestation that has resulted in the contamination of food contact surfaces, food packaging, utensils, food equipment, or adulteration of food(s). The food facility shall cease operation of the food facility immediately.**

**The food facility shall remain closed until:**

- there is no longer evidence of a vermin infestation;
- all contaminated surfaces have been cleaned and sanitized;
- contributing factors such as cleaning, repairs, and the elimination of harborages have been resolved
- discard all food that has come into contact with cockroaches
- remove all food from the floor
- clean all equipment and remove unnecessary equipment and food
- clean all floors and walls: no presence of water on floors, and floor drains and sinks shall be working properly
- approved pest control treatment

## CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **12/23/2020**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.
