The following must be completed before facility can be reopen.

1. Patch up the hole near the paper towel dispenser.
- 2 Thoroughly clean and sanitize the following items:
 - a. Behind the grease retention device.
 - b. Move out the undercounter dishwasher from under the 3 compartment sink and clean the floor and area around the dishwasher, including the dishwasher itself.
 - c. All refrigeration unit doors, door handles, and gaskets.
 - d. Empty out the reach in freezer and clean the inside.
 - e. Clean and sanitize the galvanized bulk container of all stains. If the containers cannot be thoroughly clean and sanitize, replace them with an ANSI certified (NSF, ETL or UL sanitation) container.
 - f. All shelving must near the freezer must be cleaned and sanitized.
3. Ensure there are no rodent dropping, dead cockroaches and/or live fruit flies in the facility during follow-up inspection.
4. Have a copy of the most recent pest control service on site during the reinspection.

CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **5/23/2021**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.
