Inspector Observations:

1. Observed Vermin activity at the following locations:

- One egg casing in the cabinet below the coffee station
- Two live adult cockroaches on glue traps on the counter below the coffee machine; one cockroach was observed with an attached egg casing
- One dead nymph cockroach on a glue trap in the cabinet below the coffee station
- Two live nymphs on glue traps in the cabinet below the coffee station
- One dead adult and one live nymph cockroach on a glue trap on the counter underneath the coffee machine

4. Notification: The person in charge during inspection, Jaspreet Singh, has been informed that the facility must close immediately.

[CA]: The premises of each food facility must be maintained free of vermin. The facility is required to cease operations immediately and must remain closed until all corrective actions on the provided checklist are completed.

Overall Comments:

A complaint investigation was conducted on this date. Refer to CO0159208.

On this date live cockroach activity was observed, see violation K23 for details. It was discussed that pest control is performed twice monthly by Western Exterminators with the last service completed on 3/10/26.

This facility shall remain closed until major violation K23 has been verified corrected by this department.

Facility is to immediately cease and desist all operations, including but not limited to food preparation, service, handling, distribution, and sale.

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Subsequent follow-up inspection after first follow-up shall be billed \$298/hour, minimum one hour, during normal business hours (Monday - Friday, 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM), and \$645 for a minimum of two hours, during non-business hours, and upon inspector availability.

The posted placard is property of the Santa Clara County Department of Environmental Health and shall not be removed, covered-up, relocated, tampered, or copied. Failure to comply may result in enforcement actions per County Ordinance Code Section B11-55.

If this facility is found to be in continued operation without a permit may incur a penalty of three (3) times the operating permit fee, and fee(s) for re-inspection(s) charged at the current hourly rate approved by the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors. Penalties and fees incurred due to enforcement activities must be paid in full prior to the issuance of an operating permit.

CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **4/7/2026**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing. After these violations have been corrected, you must call the Department of Environmental Health for a reinspection to reinstate the permit to operate. Phone #: (408)918-3400.
