Major Violations

K01 - 3 Points - Inadequate demonstration of knowledge; food manager certification

Inspector Observations: The employees do not have their food handler card nor were they available. Also, at least one person needs a FSC [CA] Please keep the food handler cards available and at least one FSC.

K30 - 2 Points - Food storage containers are not identified; 114047, 114049, 114051, 114053, 114055, 114067(h), 114069 (b)

Inspector Observations: Observed the container labeled raisins to be now used for holding other food items like salt or sugar. [CA] The container must say the contents.

K36 - 2 Points - Equipment, utensils, linens: Improper storage and use; 114074, 114081, 114119, 114121, 114161, 114178, 114179, 114083, 114185, 114185, 114185.3, 114185.4, 114185.5

Inspector Observations: Observed the scoop utensil in the containers of suger, salt, etc. [CA] If scoops are going to be kept in the containers then they must be stored with the handle not touching the food.
