Charged follow-up inspection; observed 2 live adult cockroaches (one near mop sink and one near security system) as well as 3 dead juvenile cockroaches in the floor drain along the cookline. Facility not ok to reopen. Facility subject to an office hearing.

1. Observed Vermin: Documented in the following areas: 2 live adult cockroaches, 1 near mop sink, the other near security system. Observed 3 dead juvenile cockroaches in floor drain along cookline.

4. Notification: The person in charge during inspection, Thao, has been informed that the facility must close immediately.

[CA]: The premises of each food facility must be maintained free of vermin. A facility cannot operate if there is a vermin infestation that leads to contamination of food contact surfaces, packaging, utensils, food equipment, or adulteration of food. The facility is required to cease operations immediately and must remain closed until all corrective actions on the provided checklist are completed.

Requirements Before Reopening:

1. Email the signed and completed Reopening Checklist to the assigned inspector.

2. Submit a copy of the pest control report from a licensed provider.

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **8/18/2026**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.
