**Inspector Observations: Over fifteen live cockroaches on several sticky traps throughout back cook line and near back walk in cooler. All live cockroaches were found on sticky traps. Two dead cockroaches found on floor next to oven. Floor was cleaned prior to inspection.**

**[CA] The premises of each food facility shall be kept free of vermin. A food facility shall not operate when there is a vermin infestation that has resulted in the contamination of food contact surfaces, food packaging, utensils, food equipment, or adulteration of food(s). The food facility shall cease operation of the food facility immediately. The food facility shall remain closed until: there is no longer evidence of a vermin infestation; all contaminated surfaces have been cleaned and sanitized; and contributing factors such as cleaning, repairs, and the elimination of harborages have been resolved.**

**[SA] Pest control was called and facility will be serviced tonight. Facility will continue to change sticky traps. If required, facility will close until cockroaches have been eliminated.**

**Note: Replace sticky traps as needed and continue to monitor - before, during, and after pesticide treatment from pest control.**
