Inspector Observations: In the back prep area, underneath a wooden tabletop, observed two cockroaches between the crevice in the middle section of the table. By the 3 compartment sink, observed a single cockroach fall from underneath the plastic push-cart, and two cockroaches on the crevices above the wheels. At the 2 door undercounter refrigerator, observed two cockroaches in the crevices of the upper hinge of the left-side door. Behind the 2 door undercounter refrigerator, observed a single cockroach behind plastic bracket holding copper piping. [CA] The premises of each food facility shall be kept free of cockroaches. A food facility shall not operate when there is a cockroach infestation that has resulted in the contamination of food contact surfaces, food packaging, utensils, food equipment, or adulteration of food(s). The food facility shall cease operation of the food facility immediately. The food facility shall remain closed until: there is no longer evidence of a vermin infestation; all contaminated surfaces have been cleaned and sanitized; and contributing factors such as cleaning, repairs, and the elimination of harborages have been resolved. Contact pest control to provide service for facility, and seal all cracks and crevices to prevent continued harborage. Contact district inspector at 408-918-1955 to schedule follow-up inspection. Follow-up inspection will be charged at a rate of \$219.00 per hour. All after hours and weekend inspections will be charged at a rate of \$493.00 per hour.
