Owner requested follow up inspection.

Observed rodent droppings on front counter by the tip jar, in open containers of what appears to be flour, on top of shelving in cook area. Observed food equipment and shelves with spices moved out to the back of facility with droppings still on the food containers and shelves. Per PIC, pest control has not come out but the handyman has been closing all holes and gaps within the facility to the outside.

Facility will remain closed at this time and will not reopen until a charged follow up inspection is conducted.

Clean and sanitize all food and nonfood contact surfaces. Remove all evidence of rodents from facility and ensure there is no evidence of vermin found at follow up inspection. If evidence of vermin is found, facility may be subject to continued closure and chargeable follow up inspections to reopen.

Facility is to cease and desist all food sales and operations, including food preparation. Do not remove, cover-up, or relocated red placard. Failure to comply may result in enforcement actions. If more follow-up inspections are conducted, there will be a \$219/hr charge at a minimum one-hour charge.

## **CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE**

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.
