Major Violations

Inspector Observations: Wiping cloth observed to be in 0ppm chlorine or 0ppm quat ammonia. [CA] Wiping towels shall be stored in sanitizing solution of an approved concentration when not in use (100 ppm - chlorine, 200 ppm - quaternary ammonium).
