Inspector Observations: Observed dried droppings in metal "stands" of the produce display and a few on top of the walk-in cooler. Also observed a large gap near the top of the ceiling above the walk-in cooler. [CA] Clean up droppings, sanitize, close/seal gaps.

Overall Comments:

Follow-up inspection; no rodent activity or evidence observed during time of inspection. Observed a few dried/dusty droppings in the metal "joints" of the produce display and a few on top of the walk-in cooler. There was also a large gap between the boards and brick wall along the upper part of the ceiling. Facility is subject to a charged follow-up inspection to ensure all droppings have been removed and gaps sealed.

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **9/25/2026**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.
