The facility is required to cease operations immediately and must remain closed until all corrective actions on the provided checklist are completed.

Follow up inspection conducted regarding closure on 07/16/2026 for vermin infestation.

Facility shall remain closed due to evidence of a vermin (cockroach) infestation.

- Facility is prohibited from all food service activities which include, but not limited to: preparation, service, handling, distribution, and sale.

- Facility shall remain closed until vermin infestation is completely abated and authorization is provided by this Division.

- This is the facility's first follow up inspection. Subsequent follow-up inspection shall be billed at \$282/hour, minimum one hour, during normal business hour, Monday - Friday 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM, and \$645 for a minimum two hours, during non-business hours, and upon inspector availability.

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- **Permit Owner to contact Supervising Environmental Health Specialist Anjani S. via cellphone number provided or via email at anjani.sircar@deh.sccgov.org to possibly schedule a follow up inspection during after hours on Sunday, 07/19/26.**

Condition to re-open on Sunday, 07/19/26:

- 1. abatement of vermin**
- 2. send completed checklist**
- 3. pest control report from a licensed pest control company confirms infestation has been abated**

- **DEH main line at (408)918-3400 to schedule a follow up inspection.**

- **The posted placard is property of the Santa Clara County Department of Environmental Health and shall not be removed, covered-up, relocated, tampered, or copied red placard. Failure to comply may result in enforcement actions per County Ordinance Code Section B11-55.**

- **A facility found to be in continued operation without a permit may incur a penalty of three (3) times the operating permit fee, and fee(s) for re-inspection(s) charged at the current hourly rate approved by the Santa Clara County Board of Supervisors. Penalties and fees incurred due to enforcement activities must be paid in full prior to the issuance of an operating permit.**

**** A period of 24 hours from this inspection shall pass before requesting a follow-up inspection. Please note that pest control treatments for rodents or insects may require a sufficient amount of contact time for these to be effective.**

CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **7/31/2026**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing. After these violations have been corrected, you must call the Department of Environmental Health for a reinspection to reinstate the permit to operate. Phone #: (408)918-3400.
