Inspector Observations:

1. Observed Vermin: Documented in the following areas:

- Live cockroaches observed harboring in the unsealed gaps under the counter above the microwave.
- A live adult cockroach with an attached ootheca (egg sac)
- A few dead cockroaches on the floor between the prep coolers.
- Numerous (10+) dead cockroaches of all life stages on the floor under the one door upright freezer next to the stock pot range.
- Heavy accumulation of cockroach feces on the wall next to the stock pot range.
- Detached FRP next to the stock pot range.
- Detached FRP next to the entrance.
- A live cockroach in the back hallway of the mall to access the facility.

3. Supervisor Notified: Anjani S.

4. Notification: The person in charge during inspection, Jingwu, has been informed that the facility must close immediately.

[CA]: The premises of each food facility must be maintained free of vermin. A facility cannot operate if there is a vermin infestation that leads to contamination of food contact surfaces, packaging, utensils, food equipment, or adulteration of food. The facility is required to cease operations immediately and must remain closed until all corrective actions on the provided checklist are completed.

2. Submit a copy of the pest control report from a licensed provider.

Overall Comments:

This is the first follow up inspection after the facility was closed for vermin activity and shall be free of charge. Any and all subsequent follow-up inspection shall be billed at \$282/hour, minimum one hour, during normal business hour, Monday - Friday 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM, and \$645 for a minimum of two hours, during non-business hours, and upon inspector availability. A signed and completed checklist for reopening and a pest control report stating no vermin activity at the facility were provided prior to this

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Observations:

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- Facility has sealed the holes in the walls of the kitchen, dishwashing area, and food storage.
 - Facility has sealed a hole in the back hallway of the mall to access the facility.
 - No rodent droppings were observed.
 - No evidence of rodent activity observed.

Facility shall remain CLOSED until authorized to reopen by this department.

CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **8/21/2026**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.
