Inspector Observations: Numerous live cockroaches observed in the following areas:

Follow-up By 09/20/2022

- 5+ cockroaches of various life stages observed behind tape and caulking on the makeshift splash guard between the right side drain board of the mechanical ware wash and the metal rack for vegetables and herbs.
- Two adult cockroaches crawling up cove basing into underneath the metal cover under the mechanical ware
- One live adult cockroach crawling on wall above the right side food preparation sink.
- One live adult cockroach observed behind electrical outlet plug below the meat slicer.

Facility was serviced by pest control company on 9/14/2022.

[CA] The premises of each food facility shall be kept free of vermin. A food facility shall not operate when there is a vermin infestation that has resulted in the contamination of food contact surfaces, food packaging, utensils, food equipment, or adulteration of food(s). The food facility shall cease operation of the food facility immediately. The food facility shall remain closed until: there is no longer evidence of a vermin infestation; all contaminated surfaces have been cleaned and sanitized; and contributing factors such as cleaning, repairs, and the elimination of harborages have been resolved.

- Facility is to remain closed until infestation has been abated.
- Cease and desist all food preparation until written authorization is granted by this Division.
- Subsequent follow-up inspections will be chargeable at \$219 per hour, minimum one hour, during normal business hours, and \$493 per hour, during non-business hours.

CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge.
