**4. Notification: The person in charge during inspection, Atulya, has been informed that the facility must close immediately.**

**[CA]: The premises of each food facility must be maintained free of vermin. The facility is required to cease operations immediately and must remain closed until all corrective actions on the provided checklist are completed.**

- 2. Submit a copy of the pest control report from a licensed provider.**

**Onsite for the 1st follow up inspection after the routine inspection.**

**Facility shall be closed effective immediately closed.**

**- K23: No rodents, insects, birds, or animals.**

**Evidence of vermin noted within the facility at the time of inspection. Noted within the following areas:**

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- Four live cockroaches on a sticky trap under the three compartment sink.
- One dead juvenile cockroach on the top of the tandoor oven.
- One dead cockroach on the floor near the mop sink.

**Facility is to remain closed and not allowed to re-open until written authorization is given by this department.**

**- Facility shall:**

- \* Eradicate all live and dead rodents and insects from the facility.
- \* Clean and sanitize the affected area(s) and equipment.
- \* Dispose of all food items that have been adulterated/contaminated.
- \* Seal holes (e.g. in walls and ceilings, repair cove base), and entryways (e.g. weather-stripping around doors); keep exterior doors closed; screen openable windows.

**- Subsequent follow-up inspection shall be billed at \$282/hour, minimum one hour, during normal business hour, Monday - Friday 7:30 AM to 4:30 PM, and \$645 for a minimum of two hours, during non-business hours, and upon inspector availability. Contact this department when you are ready for a follow up inspection.**

## CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE

When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **4/8/2026**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing. After these violations have been corrected, you must call the Department of Environmental Health for a reinspection to reinstate the permit to operate. Phone #: (408)918-3400.
