Facility received pest control service yesterday and today, observed reports from company.

Follow recommendations from pest control company, such as not harboraging cardboard, do not use over the counter treatments, and daily cleaning.

Observed contract for 6 months. Recommend monthly pest control management services for cockroaches and rodents.

Observed foods covered in dry storage room, clean daily.

Owner stated the rodent from complaint was found and killed.

Observed facility has been deep cleaned and no evidence of vermin observed. Facility OK to reopen
