Inspector Observations:

REPEAT VIOLATION

One live cockroach on floor near door for walk in cooler. Several dead cockroaches found: 1) one on wall above handwash sink near outlet, 2) one on wall against walk in cooler, 3) one on floor underneath three compartment sink, 4) two underneath storage racks, 5) two on floor in storage room, 6) one on floor next to register.

[CA] The premises of each food facility shall be kept free of vermin. A food facility shall not operate when there is a vermin infestation that has resulted in the contamination of food contact surfaces, food packaging, utensils, food equipment, or adulteration of food(s). Facility shall no longer have evidence of a vermin infestation; all contaminated surfaces have been cleaned and sanitized; and contributing factors such as cleaning, repairs, and the elimination of harborages have been resolved.

FACILITY WILL REMAIN CLOSED.

Note: Facility shall continue cleaning floors, walls, and equipment. Facility is recommended to have another pest control service immediately. Facility shall replace sticky traps as needed.

FACILITY WILL REMAIN CLOSED DUE TO PRESENCE OF LIVE COCKROACHES.

All areas with presence of live and dead cockroaches shall be cleaned and sanitized.

Sticky traps for cockroaches shall be placed around facility and replaced as needed.

Facility shall continue cleaning throughout facility. All build-ups and accumulations of grease and debris shall be removed.

All areas that may result in cockroach harborages shall be removed. Back door shall remain closed.

Facility may require more frequent pest control treatment until cockroaches are removed from facility.

Charged follow-up inspection. Facility will be billed at \$290/hr.

Any evidence of continued cockroach infestation upon re-inspection will result in facility remaining closed or a subsequent charged follow-up.

****Any subsequent follow up inspection after first follow up will be billed at \$290.00/hr during business hours and \$629 (minimum of 2 hours) during nonbusiness hours upon availability.****

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CLOSURE / PERMIT SUSPENSION NOTICE


When required to determine compliance, a single reinspection will be conducted without additional charge. If subsequent reinspections are required, an hourly fee (minimum one hour) at the current rate approved by the Board of Supervisors will be assessed for each and every reinspection until the necessary changes or corrections are made. Unless otherwise noted by the inspector, all violations are to be corrected no later than **4/25/2024**. Any major change in menu or any change in ownership must have prior approval by this Department. This may require structural and/or equipment changes or remodeling to accommodate new operations.

This notice is to inform you that as of this date the Environmental Health Permit for the above mentioned food facility is hereby suspended and all operations therewith are ordered to cease. This action is taken in accordance with Section 114409 of the California Health and Safety Code which states 'If any imminent health hazard is found, unless the hazard is immediately corrected, an enforcement officer may temporarily suspend the permit and order the food facility or cottage food operation immediately closed.'

You have the right to make a written request for a hearing within 15 days after receipt of this notice to show just cause why the permit suspension is not warranted. Failure to request such a hearing within the 15-day period shall be deemed a waiver of the right to a hearing.
